Historians never mentioned the spread of sexually transmitted diseases without highlighting the reasons behind it, such as the absence of morals and values in society; people driven towards materialism; rarity of virtue and the change in society's view towards sexual activities. There-

fore, we cannot separate morality from sex. Freud was working on these lines when he stated:

“Indeed, man does not achieve himself without sexual satisfaction ... all limitations of religion, morality and traditions are false restrictions which lead to destruct the human energy, and that it is illicit repress”.

This understanding was confirmed by “The Protocols of the Elders of Zion’, where it says:

“We must work to break down morality everywhere in order to make it easy to control others. Freud is one of us, and he will continue to expose sexual relations explicitly, so that nothing will remain sacred in young people minds, and that their main concern becomes to satisfy their sexual instincts and consequently their morals will collapse”.

As a result, the sexual revolution erupt and morals, ethics and values collapsed; a crazy sexual wave hit the roof driven and fueled by fashion, pornographic books, magazines and films, all under the pretext and cause of personal

freedom. What made things worse, is the widespread of pornography satellite channels and Internet role in broadcasting all the wired and wicked sexual practices of which young people would never thought of. Furthermore, these tools were designed in a way that it gradually pulls the youth leg into this business even without youth planning or noticing. A good example of this is one pornography website received over 22 million visitors in one year, of which viewers were between the age of 12 and 17 years old.

Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD)s are a group of infectious diseases, caused by different microbes transmitted from person to another by sexual contact; especially adultery and homosexuality and what leads to it. STDs microbes do not spread by water, air or food, but only by direct contact between the infected and the new victim. It is worth noting here, that these microbes do not infect animals despite of its sexual promiscuity.

These diseases cause physical deformities

and the infected person suffers slow and painful death which is ultimately depressing, bitter and sad way to end their lives. Socially speaking, patient's life will turn to bleak and misery since it is hard to reveal their health secrets or complain about it publically. To add insult to injury, the patient can't have much sympathy, sometimes not even from the closest relatives such as parents or their marital partner, because such diseases and its consequences such as pains and shame were avoidable.

Sexual Transmitted Diseases (STDs) in general, and AIDS, in particular, became a global health, social and economic dilemma. According to the World Health Organization, there are more than 40 million people who are HIV positive carriers in the world; 7 thousand new infections are occurring every day and further 6 thousand people die everyday because of AIDS.

FIMA became more concerned about the growing need to protect the societies in general, and the Muslim communities in particular from the scourge of this global dilemma. Our activities started in Africa then extended to South East Asia and later to the Arab region; where the WHO statistics shows that only 1% of the population is HIV positive carriers which is very low percentage comparing to the rest of the world. It is believed that this is due to the positive impact of the Islamic conduct and value system besides the cultural heritage. However, this interpretation of statistics should not encourage complacency that hold us back from facing the wide spread of this disease which is driven by the effects of globalization and new life style that eliminated many obstacles from its way.

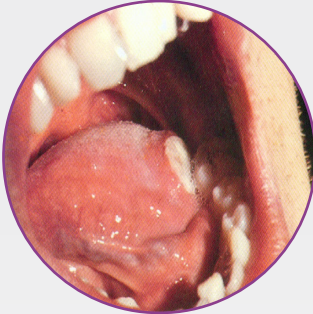
FIMA has laid down the foundation of facing these diseases on different levels, locally and globally, and since 2006 this was achieved through Youth Protection from Sex-

ually Transmitted Diseases \ AIDS' project.

We at FIMA were blessed by Allah (swt) to have an expert and a competent STDs consultant who volunteered to develop and lead the project. Dr. Abdul Hamid Al-Qudah successfully led the pioneering efforts and formed a team of workers to serve this project world wide. Dr. Al-Qudah did not spare any effort in supporting this project by working among different youth communities all over the world besides lecturing, training and authoring numerous books and leaflets in the field, as will be demonstrated in this introductory booklet.

Finally , I pray to Allah Almighty to guide, direct and bless these activities and to make these efforts purely for His sake.

Facts And Figures About Sexually Transmitted Diseases

First:

These diseases are mainly acquired by forbidden sex such as adultery, promiscuity and homosexual activities which is widely spread in some communities comparing to Muslim conservative and religious communities where sexual abstinence is the norm and marital is vital. But these communities are not immune since free attitudes to sexual activity are finding their ways to youth which is encouraged by the ummah's enemies to weaken the society and to destroy our morals. Muslims must adhere to what Allah swt commands: "And do not approach unlawful sexual intercourse. Indeed, it is ever an immorality and is evil as a way"(Q17: 32). Enemies are trying to break down morality of our youth and drag them through their sexual instincts, that is why they declared "Sex and Decedancy are the elements of the future war".

Second:

This is a global pandemic, which is more common in western societies as a result of expanding personal and sexual freedom. According to WHO statistics, 6%-7% of world population will catch a STI every year, some will recover while the rest will live with it or die as a result of the infection.

Third:

Denmark was the first country in the world to grant legal recognition to same-sex unions, in the form of “registered partnerships”, in 1989, which was followed with same sex marriage law in 2012. Numerous countries followed Denmark steps, the most recent are Ireland and USA in 2015 where gays are also allowed to serve openly in the military. This is a global direct support to spread homosexuality, despite the well-known fact that the highest rise in STIs is among homosexuals.

Fourth:

The number of STIs casualties is increasing every year. It is estimated that there are 350-500 million new cases annually, and according to WHO reports, the num-

ber was 499 million casualties in 2013. These infected patients either die, or recover if they had the suitable treatment in the right time, or live with the disease and suffer for the rest of their life from distressed and physical deformation of their sexual organs and this undoubtedly will affect his/her personal life.

Fifth:

Most of the casualties are from youth and adolescence. Youth aged between 15-25 years old are more likely to be infected with these diseases. According to Pamela Beck Reports (June 2000), more than 70% of high schools students had sex before their graduation; at least 12% caught one or more of the STIs and 20% of girls are infected with one of the STIs without even noticing. Moreover, later studies showed that these numbers and statistics had increased. Furthermore, these diseases are now present in our Muslim countries. In a study carried out in Indonesia on high school pupils by (Child Protection Commission, 2010) the results showed that 97% of pupils do watch pornography; 63% of preparatory school girls have lost their virginity; and 21% of second-

any school girls had an abortion.

Sixth:

According to the WHO, the world spends more than \$150 billion on STIs diagnoses and medicine. If this amount of money was spent wisely on developmental projects there will be no poor, illiterate or hungry people in the world.

Seventh:

The STDs were five in the past, now these have increased gradually and became up to tenfold due to the massive change in peoples sexual practices which includes oral sex and homosexuality etc. As a consequence, the STIs microbes became visible on youth tonsils and throats which led to new unknown medical cases which confused doctors. Some of which, according to recent reports in 2012 , is the increase of youth throat cancer in England which surpassed all the expectations and came in the first place in the head and neck cancers.

This reminds us with the prophetic statement: “As obscenities emerge in any nation and practiced among them openly, new pandemics of diseases and pain will

emerge as never been in their ancestors".(Al Hakim)

Eighth:

Promiscuity is naturally present among animals, but animals are exempted from these diseases.

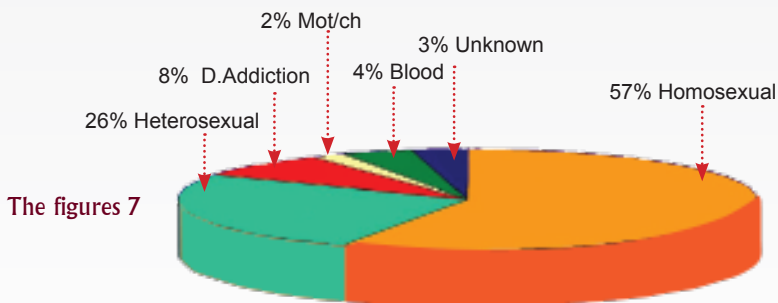
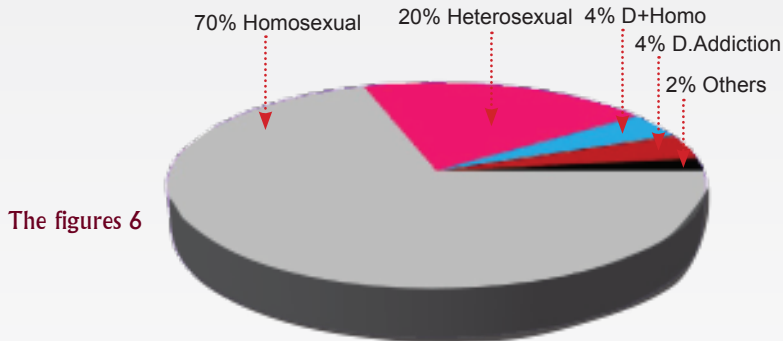
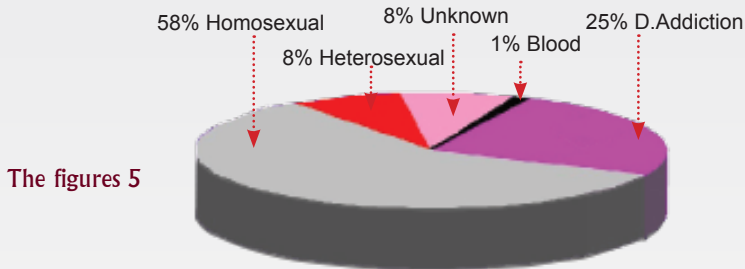
Allah (swt) grants mankind the highest cognitive abilities among His creatures which enabled them to think and act to prevent themselves from such diseases. This was supported by sending the prophets and holy books of guidance. But those who indulge in drugs and forbidden sexual practices such as promiscuity, adultery and homosexuality will be punished by suffering from such diseases in this life and in hell fire in the life after.

Nineth:

International reports regarding AIDS for the year 2000 indicated that in the US, for example, 91% of those infected with HIV/AIDS caught it in a forbidden sex (see figure 5); the percentage has gone up to 98% in 2012 (See figure 6). The figures in UK are similar (see figure 7). Therefore, we conclude that most of the infections are because of falling in the unlawful behavior and committing these prohibited practices such

as taking drugs, committing adultery and homosexuality as these are forbidden in all Abrahamic religions.

Therefore, it is evident that avoiding the forbidden is not only a way to achieve Allah's satisfaction but it is also a way to achieve protection from these STIs / AIDS and that is the ultimate aim of this project.





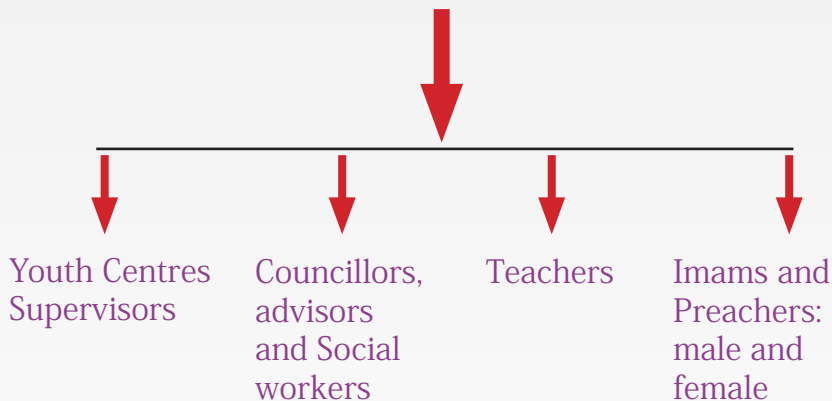
Our team at FIMA are the most qualified to bridge this gap, as they are specialised in the field; aware of the real danger and impact of these STIs on youth; vigilant to the challenges facing the Muslim youth; and because prevention is better than cure, ***we developed this project to protect youth through training and qualifying 100.000 volunteers i.e. teachers, Imams, preachers and social workers and all those who are able to learn and teach. In return all volunteers are required to deliver 10 lectures every year in order to hit our target of one million lecture and activity annually in order to increase the general awareness towards these diseases and their causes;*** to warn youth from its danger and consequences in both lives; and to explain how they can avoid these disease through religion, chastity, patience and commitment.

The Project

The idea of this project is consisting of qualifying volunteers scientifically, religiously and medically in relation to these diseases in order to lecture Muslim youth everywhere.

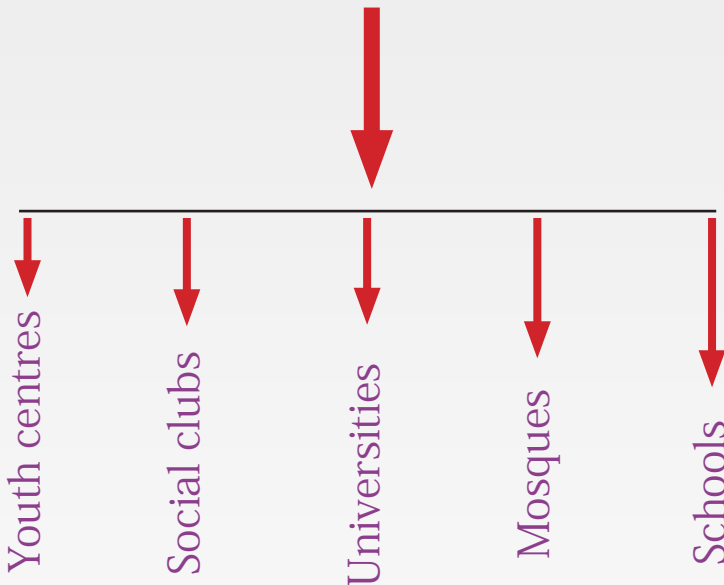

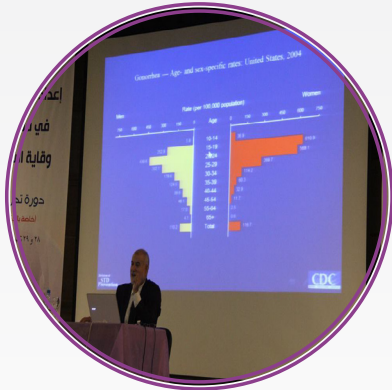
